

CONVERSATION GUIDE: Sperm Freezing

Talking to a fertility specialist may be an important step toward preserving your fertility. This tool can help you prepare your questions in advance so you can make the most of your first appointments.

How many sperm freezing procedures does your facility do each year?

What sperm freezing process do you use at your facility?

Are sperm stored here or elsewhere?

If stored off-site, how is transport handled?

What processes do you have in place to protect frozen sperm?

How do you ensure my sample will not be misidentified during the process and while in storage?

How do you ensure that my sperm stays separate from others?

How do you ensure my sperm won't be purchased or used by someone not authorized?

Who owns my sperm sample while it is in storage?

During what time of the day are appointments generally available?

Who should I contact if I have questions or concerns outside of office hours?

How long can sperm be frozen and still achieve pregnancy?

When I'm ready to use my sperm, what type of thawing procedure is used?
